
June

- Obesity is up and instituting positive behavioral change appears not to show any measurable change.
- Very disturbing news was presented regarding the Renewal of the Farm Bill. The bill allots 3% of our food subsidies to Fruits, Vegetables, nuts and legumes. This bill renews every 5 years. 63% goes to Dairy/Meet, 20% goes to Grains and 51% goes to Sugar Oil and Alcohol. It is obvious why Americans are overweight and under nourished.
- Learned that the <u>Soda Tax was defeated</u> <u>again</u> in California, but has been successful in other Philadelphia where implementing the tax created a 38% decline in sales. 1.5 center per ounce.
